		<b>EYFS</b>	<b>EYFS</b>	<b>Special me, special times – Birthdays and Christmas</b>  -what/who is special to me -when is my birthday, how do people celebrate their birthday? -Christmas is a special time for Christians, retell the Christmas story
<b>Key Stage 1</b>	<b>Year 1</b>	<b>Why is Jesus and Christmas important to Christians? Festival - Christmas</b>  -Jesus is the son of God, Jesus is kind, caring and forgiving. Jesus means ‘God saves’ -Advent is the time before Christmas, Christmas is the festival of Jesus’ birth, retell the story -Jesus was baptised (welcomed into Christianity)	<b>What do Christians believe about God and how the world was created?</b>  -God is the creator of the universe, they must respect and look after what He has made for them -Harvest says thank you to God for what He has provided/humans need to care for the world God created -Christians talk to God through prayer and worship	<b>What do Muslims believe about Allah and Muhammad? Muslim visitor</b>  -Muslims follow Islam, Allah created the universe, humans need to look after the world -Muhammad is a messenger from Allah, sent to teach his teachings -the Five Pillars of Islam show the will of Allah (faith, prayer, giving, fasting, pilgrimage)
	<b>Year 2</b>	<b>What do Christians believe about love (Agape)?</b>  -Jesus had 12 special friends called disciples -Jesus showed people love, kindness and forgiveness, this is how people need to treat other people -The Lord’s prayer is about forgiveness, people should forgive others	<b>What do Christians believe about Salvation? Festival – Easter</b>  -The Bible is the Christian holy book, it is divided into Old and New Testament -the festival of Easter remembers the last days of Jesus’ life -Jesus died so people can be forgiven and rose again from the dead, giving hope of new life	<b>What do Muslims believe about belief and commitment (iman)?</b> <b>Festival – Ramadan</b> -The Qur’an (Muslim holy book) was revealed to Muhammad on the Night of Power, retell the story - Ramadan celebrates Muhammad receiving the first revelations from the Qur’an -Muslims pray five times a day and recite the Qur’an, face Mecca

<b>Lower Key Stage 2</b>	<b>Year 3</b>	<p><b>What do Christians believe about God and incarnation?</b> <b>Church visit</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Baptism welcomes a person into the Christian Church</li> <li>-Jesus teaches Christians to believe in one God: The Father</li> <li>-Jesus is the son of God and able to perform miracles as the human incarnation of God</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Jews believe about the Torah, God and the Covenant?</b> <b>Festival – Passover</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-God first made his covenant agreement with Abraham</li> <li>-Moses received the 10 commandments from God</li> <li>-Passover is an 8-day festival celebrating the exodus of Jews from Egypt</li> <li>-Jews visit the synagogue to worship God and read the holy book the Torah</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Muslims believe about Islam and Iman?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Praying five times a day is one way Muslims submit to Allah, helps remind them what is important</li> <li>-Shahadah is the declaration of faith, which contains the Muslim creed, the Kalimah</li> <li>-Angel Gabriel was sent down with God’s holy book, the Qur’an is a copy of this book and is treated with great respect</li> </ul>
	<b>Year 4</b>	<p><b>What do Hindus believe about Dharma, deity and atman?</b> <b>Festival – Diwali</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Braham is the name of God for Hindus, they worship Braham in many different forms (deities)</li> <li>-Diwali is an important festival, it celebrates light over dark and remembers the Rama and Sita story</li> <li>-Hindus worship (puja) at the mandir and at home</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Christians believe about salvation?</b> <b>Festival – Easter</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The salvation story has four main claims, God created a perfect world, Humanity went wrong, to save Humanity, God had a salvation plan, God came as Jesus who saves humanity</li> <li>-Easter is an important festival for Christians celebrating the resurrection of Jesus. Christians believe that because Jesus died on the cross they can be forgiven by God</li> <li>-Forgiveness is important to Christians. Christians forgive the sins of others like God forgives their sins</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Christians believe about agape?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Agape love is unconditional love like God has for all of humanity. It is selfless and unconditional</li> <li>- Christians are taught how to show love and kindness to everyone, bible stories give examples</li> <li>- Christians offer help and support to their local communities</li> </ul>
<b>Upper Key Stage 2</b>	<b>Year 5</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Autumn</b></p> <p><b>What do Christians believe about God and incarnation?</b> <b>Festival – Christmas</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The Christmas story is found in two Gospels</li> <li>-Christians pray because they believe that Jesus is with them to listen and to help</li> <li>-Christians believe that God is love and it matters what people do. Jesus is God with us</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Spring</b></p> <p><b>What do Jews believe about the Torah, God and the Covenant?</b> <b>Jewish visitor</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Abraham is the founding father of the covenant</li> <li>-Jews coming of age ceremonies – bar and bat mitzvah</li> <li>-Shabbat is the Jewish day of rest</li> <li>-Jewish scriptures are called the Tenakh, the Torah is most important</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Summer</b></p> <p><b>What do Muslims believe about Islam and Iman?</b> <b>Mosque visit/Muslim visitor</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The practises Zakat (giving) and Saum (fasting) show the concept of Khalifah</li> <li>-Recall and understand the importance of the story Bilal for Muslims</li> <li>-Muhammad is the final prophet and that other prophets came before him</li> <li>-the meaning of the words Islam and Muslim</li> </ul>
	<b>Year 6</b>	<p><b>What do Hindus believe about dharma, deity and atman?</b> <b>Festival – Holi</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Hinduism is a pluralistic religion but has one supreme being – Brahman who exists in everything</li> <li>-Hindus believe in reincarnation, when the body dies their atman (soul) may move onto another being. When the soul breaks out of reincarnation it joins with Brahman</li> <li>-Holi is an important festival, it is the celebration of Spring and new life, good over evil and is a day of spreading happiness and love</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Christians believe about salvation?</b> <b>Festival – Easter</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Atonement in Christianity refers to forgiving sin through the death and resurrection of Jesus</li> <li>-Easter celebrates Jesus dying to pay the debt of humanity’s sins. Christians can be forgiven by God and live in relationship with Him, faith in Jesus gives eternal life</li> <li>-there are different baptisms but all are a symbolic way of joining the Church for Christians, using water and new life</li> </ul>	<p><b>What do Christians believe about agape?</b> <b>Church</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-The Beatitudes are part of the Sermon on the Mount where Jesus spoke to his people on a mountain about selfless, unconditional love</li> <li>-revenge means paying someone back for a wrong they have done you; reconciliation means bringing people back together who have been separated by a wrong of some sort</li> <li>-the Christian church shows the love of God to both its members and the rest of society. People should treat each other how they wish to be treated</li> </ul>
